Take Quadra ferry from Campbell River to Quathiaski Cove (15 min.)

Ferries from Campbell River run on the half hour eg. 3:30 pm (arrive half hour in advance)

Drive across Quadra Island, call the taxi, or ask for a ride to Heriot Bay (15 min.).

Follow signs across Quadra Island to Cortes Island Ferry & Heriot Bay. Take ferry to Cortes Island.

- FROM CANADA
- 1. Book flight to Vancouver. Arrive by 1pm.
- 2. AIRPORTER SHUTTLE or TAXI to Westin Bay Shore Inn and CORILAIR SEAPLANES dock.
- 3. CORILAIR SEAPLANES direct to Cortes Island: 888-287-8366, www.corilair.com.
- FROM U.S.
- 1. Book flight to Vancouver or Seattle. From Vancouver see above. Arrive in Vancouver or Seattle by 11am.
- 2. From SeaTac take Kenmore Shuttle to Kenmore Lake Washington Terminal.
- 3. KENMORE AIR seaplanes to Cortes Island and land based flights from Seattle, WA to Campbell River, BC, 866-435-9524 or 425-486-1257, www.kenmoreair.com. On flights to Campbell River, there is free one way shuttle service to ferry and water taxi docks.
